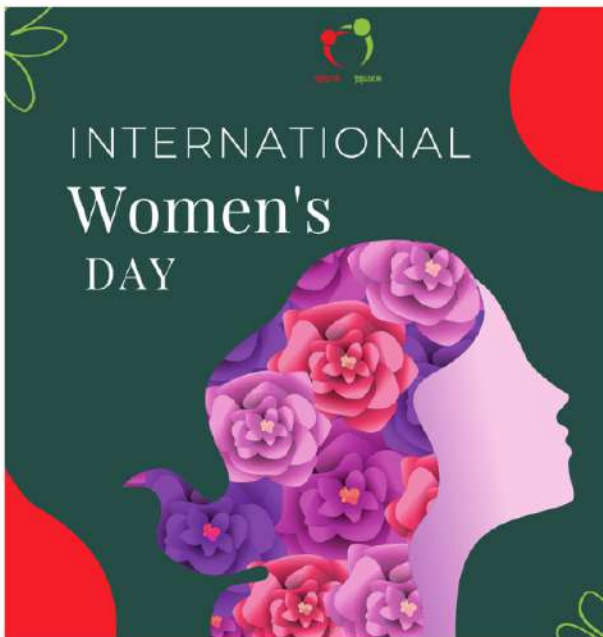

- #4 - \$20: A diverse poultry selection with Tienda Pollo Casero, leg quarters, drumsticks, fajita chicken, and ground turkey.
