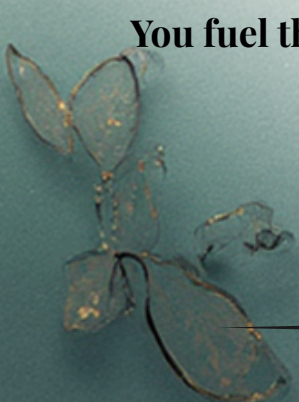
That is why we consider it our sacred privilege to stand in the gap for you.
